CINCONDING This home in Fremantle, WA, is a place of solace and recuperation for a fly-in, fly-out professional. Working with a modest budget, PHILIP STEJSKAL ARCHITECTURE created a compact and durable home that spirals from an introverted brick base. Like the rest of the home, the kitchen is composed of unassuming materials and off-the-shelf components – for example, the splashback is made of structural brick. In contrast to the light and airy spaces in other areas, the simple kitchen has an atmosphere of privacy and moodiness that radiates from its dark joinery and benchtop.
